The courses are used to deliver theoretical knowledge and help students develop their competences in the use of methods important to accomplish the project in question. Students are supported and supervised by internationally active professors and experts. In this way, both the company and the student receive benefits in the form of qualified support and consulting during the entire period of study and writing/defending the Master's thesis.

Furthermore, scientific and project activity under the guidance of our experts contributes to the development of our students' personal, social and communication skills.
